2. Description of contributions made - Describe some initial contributions made to the project that have been completed so far. Recognition as a Collaborator does not require that you have fully completed your contribution, but we ask that you have started the process of contributing.
3. Pointers to contributions (optional) – Send us links to any contributions you have made (for instance, links to Jira tickets, Gerrit patches or results in the metrics dashboard).
4. Feedback and suggestions - If you have any thoughts or suggestions about what could be done to make contributing to the project easier, we would be very interested in your feedback. For instance, was information about how to contribute missing or hard to find, were there roadblocks that slowed you down, could things have been improved in some way?
